

## Dear Spring 2020 Sturly Abroad Sturlents,

As part of a coronavirus stimulus package approved by Congress, the University of St. Thomas has received \$2.5 Min federal funding to provide emergency cash grants to sturkents. The federal CARES Act funds cambe awarded to sturkents who are eligible for federal financial aid. We invite all sturkents eligible for federal financial aid and have expenses related to the disruption of St. Thomas campus operations due to COVID 19 to apply to the CARES Act Emergency Grants. The CARES Act specifically calls out expenses related to sturky abroad travel and disruption to sturky abroad experiences as one of the categories to be eligible for a grant.

St. Thomas recognizes that students across the university have been affected by the campus disruption due to COVID 19, including students who do not meet the eligibility criteria for a CARES Act emergency grant. We encourage students who are ineligible for the CARES ACT Emergency grants, including our DACA/Dreamer and international students, to apply for emergency grants under the St. Thomas Student Emergency Assistance Programfor COVID
