

Surface travel and transfers: Private deluxe motorcoach will be used for local touring and transportation.

Accommodations and meals: Shared hotel occupancy in twinbedded room or room with one double bed as indicated in non-smoking rooms. U.S. king and queen bed sizes are often not available. A double bed may actually be two twin beds arranged side by side. Supplemental cost for single room occupancy is \$1,048. Included are fourteen meals, including breakfast daily, one lunch, and three dinners.
