To be eligible to take course s, students must be a junior or senior (or its equivalent) in high school, submit a high school transcript showing a cumulative GPA of 3.5 (weighted if applie able) or higher, have an appropriate school administrator submit a Statement of Support Form an d, if less than 18 years of age, have a parent/guardian submit a Parent Consent Form.

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days before the start of each term on a space-available basis. They are limited to enrolling for eight credits during each of the fall and spring semesters, four credits during the January-term and a combined total of 16 credits during the summer sessions. If a course has prerequisite requirements, high school students may enroll in that course only if they meet all the requirements. Althou gh high school students are not classified as first-year, sophomore, junior, or senior, any courses they complete are part of their permanent pos tsecondary academic record. High school students who wish to pursue a degree program after high school graduati on must make a formal application for admission through the Office of Admissions. For these st udents, like all other non-degree students, a maximum of 24 credits taken at St. Thomas before acceptance in a degree program may be applied toward a St. Thomas degree program.

Non-degree students, including high school stud
